Chorus (1+2)


Bridge (1+2)


Verse (a+b)


Chorus (1+2)


Finishes with 3 bars of G and 1 bar of E chord whilst whistling. (repeat)










Here are all the lead solo parts.


Verse Solo










Here are the chords which are used in the song. They are not in order.
